**Bountiful Blueberries: Planning, Planting and Care- April 23<sup>rd</sup>**  
*Free Seed, Sow & Grow program hosted by Boston Natural Areas Network*

**BOSTON, MA**, April 20, 2011, – No luck with blueberries? Learn how to succeed with this delicious and sometimes challenging fruit. Jeremy Dick, BNAN Horticulturist, will discuss soil preparation, planting, fertilizing and seasonal maintenance of blueberry plants.

In its ongoing role as a resource to Boston's 10,000 community gardeners, Boston Natural Areas Network is offering a special free program, **Bountiful Blueberries: Planning, Planting and Care**, on Saturday April 30 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. as part of its *Seed, Sow & Grow* horticultural series. The program will be held at Paul Gore & Beecher Streets Community Garden in Jamaica Plain.

**Registration is required** and registering early is recommended. The program is limited to 30 participants. Participants should dress appropriately and be aware that outdoor programs may be cancelled due to rain or severe weather.

The *Seed, Sow & Grow* horticultural series is free and open to the public and presented February through October by BNAN staff, volunteers, local horticultural professionals and knowledgeable graduates of BNAN's Master Urban Gardener Program.
