**Enjoy Trees Shrubs and Wild Edibles along the Neponset River**

*Free Event Hosted by Boston Natural Areas Network  
Tuesday Evening June 7 at 6 p.m.*

**BOSTON, MA**, May 31, 2011 – The Neponset River, flowing through Milton and Dorchester, hosts a wide and varied habitat before it empties into Boston Harbor. On Tuesday, June 7 at 6:00 p.m., you are invited to join Boston Natural Areas Network and Russ Cohen of MA Dept. of Fish and Game to take an evening walk along the newest Neponset Greenway trail section and discover the diverse habitat along the path. Russ will be our guide, and in addition to identifying the various vegetation, he will point out wild edibles along the way.

Participants will meet at the 7 Brush Hill Road parking area, on the Milton side of the river, near Mattapan Square. This program is free and open to the public, and cancels only in extreme weather.
